Gliding

The F3J thermal competition was held at KAMS 27 April 24 with 9 competitors. Winch launches were undertaken for the rounds with challenging conditions prevailing. Those able to read the air did achieve great times.. After the collation of scores, Chris Barrenger managed to lead the field with Simon Watts and Steve Maitland hot on his heels.

Dorothy Buckley Trophy

The Dorothy Buckley trophy is awarded to participants flying in AWA sanctioned State Competitions, the contestant achieving the most points allocated in the calendar year wins. Contest Directors provide the report to the AWA Contest Secretary. Points are allocated 7 first, 5 2nd, 3 for third place and all other competitors 1 point each. Team race points are divided.
