The events held consist of control line, free flight, gliding, old timers (SAM270) and multi-rotor. As the events are completed, Contest Directors provide a report to the AWA Contest Secretary. For those competing, points are allocated towards the Trophy decided at the end of the calendar year, 7 points (1st), 5 points (2nd), 3 points (3rd) and all other competitors earn 1 point each. Team events points are divided.
